The Government organized Measles-Rubella (MR) vaccination campaign will be held in the school premises on Monday, 23rd July 2018 as per following schedule.

Classes	Time
IV to VII	08:00 a.m. to 09:30 a.m.
I to III	9:30 a.m. to 10:30 a.m.
VIII to X	10:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.

The school has decided to declare a holiday for Classes I to X in order to facilitate the same.

- Parents are required to bring their child/ward to school, get them vaccinated and then take them home on that day.
- The student is advised to rest after receiving the vaccination.
- They are required to have sufficient, healthy food before taking this vaccine. Please ensure this at home before coming. The vaccine will not be administered if the child comes on an empty stomach.
- Students suffering from fever, epilepsy, kidney problems and/or health problems are advised NOT to take this vaccine.
- The vaccine injection will be given on the arm of the child. The medical officials will be using sealed 'one time use only' disposable syringes for the process.



Subject: Supporting Measles-Rubella (MR) Vaccination Campaign


The state of Gujarat is conducting the MR vaccination campaign as part of the national strategy to eliminate Measles and control Rubella/CRS in the country. All children aged 9 months up to 15 years will be provided with an additional dose of MR vaccine, regardless of any previous vaccination status or history of measles/rubella-like illness.

Measles and rubella are highly infectious diseases caused by a virus. An estimated nearly 49,000 children die from measles annually, making it one of the leading causes of child deaths in India. Rubella virus affects both children and adults can cause death and disabilities in the new born if an unprotected pregnant woman gets infected with rubella virus in early pregnancy. Measles and rubella can be prevented by immunizing children, which is safe and effective.

Measles Rubella vaccination campaign offers a second opportunity to ensure population immunity against measles and rubella. The aim of the campaign is to cover 100% of the targeted children (around 1.6 crores) and achieve herd immunity in the population which favours disease control and elimination. In our country 20 states have already completed the MR Vaccination campaign with successful achievement of 95% coverage starting its launch from February 2017. The MR campaign will be conducted in our state from 16th July 2018 for a period of 4-5 weeks. Vaccination will be conducted in schools during the first 2 weeks and later on in the community through outreach sessions.

As around 70% of the children aimed are present in schools, the Departments of Health and Education are partnering with schools to bring students and teachers to jointly participate in the MR Campaign. All schools – public and private, including other institutions must participate actively in this campaign. It is observed that some schools are requesting letters from state authorities for providing support in the campaign.

This is to request you to please issue a directive to all schools to ensure that all children in the target age definitely get vaccinated during the campaign **even if they have been vaccinated earlier for MR/MMR**. Your active participation in the campaign will be highly appreciated.
